"Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day." Psalm 119:97

The Bible comforts me...it encourages me and gives me hope...it gives me counsel and direction...it gives me wisdom for every situation that I face daily...it cleanses me from sin...it heals my broken heart...it gives me peace and joy...it restored my broken marriage.

Psalm 40:8 reads, "I delight to do Your will, O my God, and Your law is within my heart." Beloved, many professing Christians do not read the Bible, and many read and study but do not obey it. I read it for a close intimate relationship with my Father God, with my Savior and Friend Jesus Christ, and with my Friend the Holy Spirit.

I encourage you to spend time daily reading the Bible, building a close relationship with Jesus Christ, and through it, God's Amazing grace will transform your life. Again, build a close relationship with Jesus Christ and through that and obedience to God's Word, God will transform your life.
