John 3:19-21 reads, "And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God." From this scripture, it is easy to tell if we love light or darkness. If we are true believers, we will love light. Jesus is the only true light! If we love Jesus, we will love His Word. If we love Jesus, we will obey His Word. We will hate sin.
