“Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.” Psalm 23:4 (NKJV)

He had been in many dangerous situations and could confidently and boldly say, *“...I will fear no evil; for You are with me...”*

As a young shepherd boy, David had firsthand experience of God’s power, strength, and protection many times. Once he fought and killed a lion that was attacking his sheep. Once he fought and killed a bear to save the lives of the sheep. To care for the sheep, David had battled blistering heat, freezing storms, raging winds, swollen rivers and constant

attacks by different wild beasts. Over and over again, he had been in the shadow of death and in the midst of evil. His trust and confidence in God’s protection to safely bring him through each valley situation was based on experience. David could boldly say, because of experience, my God is with me.

Beloved believer, are you in a valley of evil today? Are you in a situation that is like a lion or a bear trying to destroy you? Are you battling a heated situation, or is someone trying to freeze you with rejection, a job loss, or a divorce? Are you battling raging winds and swollen rivers of turmoil in your home and in your finances or constant attacks against your health?

Do not listen to the lies of Satan. Jesus has not left you alone. He is in your valley with you. He will not leave you there. He is teaching you to trust Him. The valleys of life are where we need to draw closer to Jesus and where we will find He is always close to us. God’s amazing grace has faithfully taken me through many, many valleys. And I know and I have an assurance that He is with me in the ones that I am in now. Unbeliever, put your trust in Jesus as your Savior. He will never fail you.
